There were ten locates completed. One new sewer tap was inspected at 3850 W. Latonka Road. A new sewer service issue was responded to at 3285 W. Bellwood Drive.

____7. Sheridan #1: Cynthia Lane is continuing to meet with the city of Sheridan about the project. The developer should go to closing in mid-January. Cynthia met with the developer and the city in January. The developer is very clear about the expectations of the district including the fact that the developer, the city of Sheridan and Sheridian #1 will have to pay for the rehabilitation of the system. They will also have to pay the full tap fee for each unit. Tim Flynn will be drafting agreements. He is not charging any of his time to Valley Sanitation for this work. The charges will be wrapped up to Sheridan #1. The city of Sheridan and developer will be required to reimburse Platte Canyon for any reviews and the attorney fees for the project. Cynthia discussed the state requirements for lift station design. It's a state requirement to go through the same process that is required for all lift stations. The HOA for the development will be responsible for the lift station.

___9. Capital Project Update: The project is getting started. The pre-construction meeting will be February 23, 2023. The start date will be discussed at the meeting.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 PM. The next meeting will be Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at 5:00 pm, at Platte Canyon Water and Sanitation, 8739 W. Bowles Avenue, Littleton, CO.
